
Darlene Olson MCRW Tribute Honoree #3

The fourth Texas Federal of Republican Board of Directors' meeting was held on September 16, 2022, in Georgetown, Texas, at the Sheraton Convention Center. This meeting was the fourth board meeting of the year, and, as SD 31 District Director, I attended all of them. This board meeting was part of the weekend that featured "Tribute to Women" on Saturday at noon. We are always honored to have special speakers at our Board Meetings, and this event featured the excellent speaker Melissa Conway who heads the Election Integrity Campaign in Texas. The second guest speaker was State Senator Brandon Creighton, the chair for Texas Victory 2022. Senator Creighton and his family reside in Conroe where he represents SD 4.

Items stressed at this meeting included getting new officers trained and submitting reports in a timely manner. Membership VP Melanie Grammar wanted all Membership chairs to know that only renewals of membership go on the December 31 submission with the slate of officers. If you have New Members, they need to be submitted after January 1, 2023. This requirement is a NFRW rule that we need to follow. The second substantial change was an increase of the fee for Board Meeting Registration to \$75. Inflation has hit all the Convention prices, and we must now pay for things that were free in the past.

Upcoming dates to remember are February 3, 2023, Legislative Day at the AT&T Conference Center in Austin; First Quarter TFRW Board Meeting on February 2, 2023, at the same location; and the 2023 NFRW Convention on September 28-30, 2023, in Oklahoma City. The TFRW State Convention is October 12-14, 2023, in Irving Texas. These major events are for your officers and club members to attend, with prominent Republican elected officials in attendance and great workshops.
